

**MOHAWK COUNCIL OF KAHNAWÀ:KE ELECTION LAW
REGULATION RESPECTING FORMS AND DECLARATIONS,
PREPARATION OF THE POLL, VOTING PROCESS, AND COUNTING OF
VOTES**

K.R.L. c. E-1- r.2

Enacted by MCED #73/2017-2018 on 19 Enniskó:wa/March 2018

SHORT TITLE

1.1 This Regulation may be cited as the “MCK Election Regulation”.

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

2.1 The Nomination Form will be in the form attached as Schedule "A" to this Regulation.

VERIFICATION PROCEDURE

3.1 The Declaration of Candidacy will be in the form attached as Schedule "B" to this Regulation.

3.2 The Declaration of Eligibility will be in the form attached as Schedule "C" to this Regulation.

3.3 The Declaration of Criminal Offence Charge Pending will be in the form attached as Schedule "D" to this Regulation.

3.4 The Declaration of Business Holdings will be in the form attached as Schedule "E" to this Regulation.

3.5 The Privacy Waiver will be in the form attached as Schedule "F" to this Regulation.

PREPARATION OF THE POLL

4.1 The Electoral Officer will procure as many ballot boxes as are required and will prepare a sufficient number of ballots for the purpose of the election.

4.2 Every ballot box will be constructed in a manner that allows the ballots to be deposited therein, but not removed without breaking the lock or seal.

4.3 The ballots will indicate in capital letters, the names of the candidates, as provided in the candidate's nomination forms, and will be listed in alphabetical order.

- 4.4 A boxed space will be provided on the ballots horizontally aligned with each candidate's name into which Electors may mark their vote.
- 4.5 Each ballot will bear the name of the community, the date of the election, the number of candidates to be elected and the phrase "Mark your ballot with an X", on the top portion thereof.
- 4.6 The reverse side of each ballot will have space provided for the initials of the Electoral Officer or the Assistant Electoral Officer, and the initials of a Polling Clerk.
- 4.7 The Electoral Officer will, before the poll is open, deliver to the Polling Clerks the ballot boxes, the ballots, materials for marking the ballots, copies of the Voters List and direction for the voting procedure.
- 4.8. The Electoral Officer and Assistant Electoral Officer will, immediately before the commencement of the poll:
 - (a) open the ballot boxes and call such persons as may be present to witness that the boxes are empty; and
 - (b) will then lock or seal the ballot boxes in full view of those present.
- 4.9 If ballot boxes become full, they may be opened periodically during the course of the day for the purpose of transferring the contents into a larger box. This process is to be witnessed by two (2) persons, preferably by candidates.

VOTING PROCESS

- 5.1 An Elector, upon receiving a ballot, will forthwith proceed to one of the polling compartments provided for marking the ballots and then mark the ballot, by placing an "X" in the box horizontally aligned with the name of the candidate or candidates for whom he or she chooses to vote.
- 5.2 While an Elector is in a polling compartment, no other person will be allowed in the same compartment, or be in any position from which he or she can see the manner in which the Elector marks his ballot.
- 5.3 The Elector will then fold his or her ballot so as to conceal the names of the candidates he has voted for, but in such a way that the initials of the Electoral Officer, Assistant Electoral Officer or Polling Clerk are exposed. The ballot will then be delivered to the person who issued it, and that person will verify their initials and at once and in full view of those present, deposit the ballot in the ballot box. The Polling Clerk will then note on the Voters List that the Elector has voted.
- 5.4 An Elector who receives a spoiled or improperly printed ballot, or who has dealt with the ballot in such a manner that it cannot be conveniently used, is entitled to receive another ballot, by returning it to the person who issued it. The Electoral

Officer will thereupon write the word "CANCELED" on the spoiled ballot and preserve it.

- 5.5 An Elector who declares that they are unable to personally mark their ballot, by reason of a disability or because they cannot read, may be assisted by the Electoral Officer, Assistant Electoral Officer or Polling Clerk. The name of the Elector should be recorded in a specified log.
- 5.6 Any person who has received a ballot and who leaves the polling place without returning it, or, if after receiving same, refuses to vote, will forfeit his right to vote at that election. The Electoral Officer will make a note that such person received a ballot and declined to vote, in which case, the Electoral Officer will mark upon the face of the ballot the word "DECLINED" and all ballots so marked will be preserved.

COUNTING OF VOTES

- 6.1 Immediately after the polls have officially closed counting stations will be set up with two (2) Polling Clerks and a minimum of two (2) representatives of candidates in each station. Candidates may observe counting stations if they wish.
- 6.2 Each counting station will be in a secure location and the ballot boxes must never be left unattended and must at all times be monitored by at least two (2) individuals.
- 6.3 One Polling Clerk will examine each ballot and the second Polling Clerk will keep a tally of the votes cast for each candidate.
- 6.4 The Electoral Officer will provide each counting station with a ballot box consisting of ballots. No ballots will be added to or removed from the location of the counting station unless authorized by the Electoral Officer.
- 6.5 Upon receipt of a ballot box, the first Polling Clerk will empty the contents of the ballot box onto a table and proceed with the count.
- 6.6 During the count, the first Polling Clerk will closely examine each ballot, read aloud the candidate(s) selected, show the ballot to each person present and ask the second Polling Clerk to tally the vote in favor of the candidate for whom the vote(s) was cast. The representatives of candidates will also keep a tally of the votes cast for each candidate.
- 6.7 After every 40 ballots are counted, the second Polling Clerk will confirm their count with that of the representatives of candidates present. In the event of a discrepancy the ballots will be recounted until such time as the vote totals of the second Polling Clerk match the vote totals of the representatives of candidates.
- 6.8 In counting the votes, the Electoral Officer will reject any ballot:

- (a) that was not initialed by the Electoral Officer or Assistant Electoral Officer;
 - (b) that is blank;
 - (c) on which there appear to be more votes than there are positions to be filled;
 - (d) on which there appear marks or writing identifying the Elector; or
 - (e) any vote that does not clearly indicate the Elector's intention.
- 6.9 Where a candidate or candidate's representative objects to a decision of the Electoral Officer concerning the counting of a vote in a community election, the Electoral Officer will;
- (a) decide any question arising out of the objection;
 - (b) record the objection and the decision in an appropriate log; and
 - (c) write on the back of a ballot the word or words "ALLOWED", "ALLOWED IN PART", or "REJECTED", as the case may be, and initial the ballot.
- 6.10 No ballot will be disqualified by reason only that the mark adjacent to the name of the candidate is not an "X".
- 6.11 The Polling Clerks will also note the number of ballots cast and the number of rejected ballots.
- 6.12 Once all ballots have been counted and all vote totals tallied, the Polling Clerks and the representatives of candidates present will sign a statement that records the number of votes cast for each candidate, the number of ballots counted, and the number of ballots rejected. The statement will be provided to the Electoral Officer.
- 6.13 Upon receipt of the statements from each counting station, the Electoral Officer will tabulate the final results.

AMENDMENTS

- 7.1 This Regulation may be amended pursuant to the established rules for amending Regulations which are in force at the time the Regulation is amended.

SCHEDULE "C"

DECLARATION OF ELIGIBILITY

I, _____ declare that I meet the eligibility criteria set out in the *Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke Election Law* to be a candidate for the office of Grand Chief or Chief of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke. More specifically, I declare that I:

- (a) meet the requirements of the Kahnawà:ke Membership Law, and I am listed as a member on the Kahnawà:ke Kanien'kehá:ka Registry and my benefits and entitlements as a member are not currently suspended;
- (b) have fifty (50 %) percent or more Kanien'kehá:ka Blood quantum;
- (c) am Kanien'kehá:ka of Kahnawà:ke and not a member of any other Kanien'kehá:ka community;
- (d) am not married to or living common-law with a non-Native person;
- (e) am over the age of twenty-one (21) years;
- (f) am ordinarily resident in Kahnawà:ke ;
- (g) will declare all my private business holdings in order to verify conflicts of interest if elected and/or respond to public inquiry of Chiefs and will allow the Electoral Officer to make said declaration available to any Elector who wishes to see it prior to Election Day.;
- (h) have not been, within the previous six (6) years, convicted and sentenced for a criminal offense as defined by the MCK Election Law. The six (6) year ban commences only after the sentence has been served in full;

By signing this Declaration, I give my consent that if elected to the position of Grand Chief or Chief of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke I will submit to a test to verify that I do not use illegal drugs. I understand and agree that if I do not pass this test, I will no longer be eligible to hold the position of Grand Chief or Chief of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke and will be removed from office.
