## **CDMP REGULATIONS FLOWCHART**

PHASE I

**Step 1** →The designated body (Board, Commission...) mandated through the law **initiates** drafting regulations and referred to as the Drafting Committee. In the absence of a designated body, MCK delegates responsibility to the appropriate Unit or Department.

Drafting Committee writes Regulations using MCK/KLCC Guidelines to reflect the spirit and intent of the law.

PHASE II

**Step 1**  $\rightarrow$  Community Input Process, where Drafting Committee gathers input from the community is a period of time starting from the date of publication of the draft regulation ending 30 days later.

Method of consultation can vary (i.e. kiosks, written memos, community consultation, etc.).

Redrafted Regulations presented to Chief and Council.

↓
Step 1 → Chief and Council gives final approval of Regulations through a MCED at Legislative Session.

PHASE III

**Step 2**  $\rightarrow$  Final Regulations are posted online.

**Step 2**  $\rightarrow$  Drafting Committee identifies (sends out public notification) & consults with Stakeholders for input when writing or amending Regulations.

**Step 3**  $\rightarrow$  Council receives and considers Draft Regulations and approves any additional operational and/or financial costs.

**Step 4** → Draft Regulations posted online for 30 days. First Community Input Process occurs during 30-day review period.
