Joel Jacobs informed that the Kahnawà:ke Occupational Safety & Health Act (KOSHA) has been changed and given the working title of **Kahnawà:ke Worker's Compensation Act** (KWCA)

- (the previously entitled) KOSHA has been broken down into 3 elements. They are: MSI, OSHA and Qualifications & Benefits
- LCC will forward to Council the resubmission of KWCA & confirmation of recategorization as a Type I Legislation.

2. <u>2011/12 LEGISLATIVE AGENDA</u>

Linda provided an update on the eight (8) pieces of legislation currently being handled by the LCC.

Membership Law

- Telephone survey complete
- MCK Communications is compiling information. SDU will disseminate information once completed.

Anti-Tobacco Law

- Information gathering. Once complete, Communication Strategy will be sent to LCC
- Proponent wants complete ban on tobacco except for ceremonial purposes.

Judicial Act

- Dale Dione-Dell, Community Representative stepped down and was replaced by alternate, Richard Nolan. Other Community Representatives are Jeremiah Johnson and Christine Bush-Diabo. Technical Team is looking for a new alternate from community hearings list of interested persons.
- Status quo from last Strategic Discussion. Best case scenario for completion of this law:
 - ▶ First Draft is tentatively scheduled to go to the community in June 2011
 - Second Draft July 2011
 - ➢ Finalization − August 2011
 - Enactment / Implementation Autumn 2011
- Justice Technical Team is in place. Council is always welcome and invited to attend. A Technical Team meeting is scheduled for tonight from 6:00 8:00 p.m.
