Ron will be working on preparing a budget before it goes for enactment, which should take place in mid-May — early June 2014.  Kahente noted that she responded to a community member's e-mail to set the record straight regarding non-native reporters from The Eastern Door attending CDMP Hearings.  MRI: Next Hearing tentatively set for Tuesday, April 29, 2014. Joe reported that the MRI Draft is completed and ready to be released to the public. There will be commercials on KTV advertising the law and upcoming Hearing.  ACTION: Contact Paul Nicholas for copy of Draft MRI Law posting on KLCC website (www.kahnawakemakingdecisions.com).  Membership: Next Consultation tentatively scheduled for April 1 & 15, 2014. However, it depends on the date that MRI picks for its next Hearing.
