File Updates	<p><b><u>Justice System (Act)</u></b>            –Next Justice Hearing - November 28, 2012 @ Karonhianonha School Gym – 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.  <b>Question:</b> Do we have the ‘Confirmation of the Will of the People’ with low participation?  <b>Response:</b> The people have given their confirmation and the direction to create a Justice System given by the people prior to the drafting of the Justice System.</p> <p><b><u>MRI</u></b>            -Council Discussions this morning resulted in the following changes to Urgent Process:            1) Once categorized, C &amp; C orders suspension of normal process;            2) Timeline based on urgency – 1 year less 1 day;            3) Explain why and what happens if not completed within timeframe. If not done, original law null and void.            -KLCC to launch Urgent Process through MCK Communications on Tuesday, November 20, 2012.            -Council &amp; Technician to decide plan of action to determine Drafting of Law procedure (i.e. Use of Six Nations, Akwesasne’s or Kahnawà:ke’s).</p> <p><b><u>Alcoholic Beverages Law</u></b>            -Request received from Technician to resubmit through CDMP</p> <p><b><u>Membership Law</u></b>            –Launching extensive Membership Law campaign to include four community information sessions on Nov. 20, 21, 22 &amp; 24, 2012, a KML pamphlet, two videos and interviews.            -First Community Consultation: Thursday, January 24, 2012 – 6:00 to 8:30 p.m. @ Karonhianonha</p> <p><b>Decision:</b>            1) Do not duplicate documents already posted online (<a href="http://www.kahnawakemakingdecisions.com">www.kahnawakemakingdecisions.com</a>)            2) Ensure all documents are in PDF            3) Ensure all documents do not contain any names of individuals            4) Post summaries with links to documents.</p>

Miscellaneous	<p><b><u>CDMP Telephone Survey</u></b></p> <p>In effort to promote CDMP, looking into hiring a student to conduct telephone survey to poll the people in Kahnawake on their knowledge of the CDMP and to try to engage the community to get more participation at the community meetings. Discuss questions that need to be asked in survey to see if they are measurable.</p> <p><b>Suggested Questions:</b></p> <p>1) The Process was designed as a response from people’s input in the creation of Kahnawà:ke Laws; do you still feel that way?</p> <p>2) If you do not want to keep the CDMP, what is the alternative to law making? Would you rather have the MCK Chiefs make all the laws without community input?</p>
