Introduction Interim KLCC Assistant	Kim Beauvais was introduced and welcomed onto KLCC.
2. File Updates	Justice — Enactment of Justice System scheduled for mid to end of May. Ron reported that completing Mandate and Terms of Reference. Exploring scope of jurisdiction with issues around pillars of independence and appointment of Justices. Transitioning out by March 31, 2016 from Justice to Public Security. Kevin Fleischer to replace Ron Skye as Director of Justice on KLCC. Tobacco — Feedback Report & Draft Law currently is being revised. Gina to present both documents to Council then will be posted online. Decision made by the Drafting Team to read the draft law out at the First Hearing to ensure everyone understands the content, then the feedback will be addressed. ACTION: Leslie to request that Gina invites KLCC when she presents revised feedback report and draft law to Council. Membership — Next Hearing scheduled for Wednesday, May 6, 2015. A premeeting to be scheduled to review action plan for the next CDMP Hearing. Press release to inform community that Jurisdiction, Definitions & if time permitting, the Role of the Registrar to be discussed at upcoming hearing. Kahsennenhawe reported that she is working with Communications to prepare a video to be aired on YouTube and KTV giving a snap shot of the history of membership starting with the Seigneury. It was reported that a community member was frustrated after being told at the First Hearing that this law could be reviewed before the 5-year mandatory review.

It was then clarified that unless there was an urgent need to re-amend any law; all laws could only be reviewed after 1 year of enactment. Suggestion to inform public that the last CDMP will be held on May 6 and will resume in late August or early September 2015. **Residency Law** – This will not be addressed until the Winter 2015 or early 2016 because the Legislative Calendar is booked with Tobacco and Membership Hearings and also because the MRI also has to go back through the CDMP Regular Process before October 27, 2015. **ACTION:** Leslie to inform the two community members that submitted the request for a Residency Law that it would only be able to go through the CDMP in the winter 2015 or sometime in 2016. 3. CDMP **Feedback** – A brief overview was given. Final report to be presented to Council **Revisions** in September. A suggestion was given to provide a professional(s) to debate/give a presentation to the community on both sides of the issue when consensus cannot be reached at CDMP meetings. It's a political issue that requires information in order for the community to make an informed decision. **KLCC Composition** - To include the Director of Public Security. **Development of MCK/KLCC Guidelines** – Briefly discussed with the decision for Leslie to clarify with Jean. 4.
