1. Previous ROC	Please review the $04/24/15$ ROC and send any changes by 4:00 p.m. today as they will be finalized at that time.	
2. Mandate	The CDMP Procedural Manual is currently being revised by Leslie, Kahsennenhawe & Kevin. Rather than scheduling a KLCC meeting for clarification on any required changes, it was agreed to contact KLCC through e-mail for confirmation.	
	The following changes were made to the Mandate to be brought back to Council for approval:	
	Composition: added 1 youth to KLCC Community Representatives for a total 3 full-time reps rather than 1 lead and 1 alternate. added 1 ad hoc MCK organizational representative changed to 2 Chiefs Advisory – 1 lead & 1 alternate changed to KLCC Interim or Coordinator having voting privileges	
	<u>Discussion</u> : Original intent was that KLCC would be the legislative body composed of 1 lawyer, 2 policy writers and at least 3 community representatives permanently assigned to KLCC, but presently we aren't ready financially. This is the direction KLCC needs to take in the near future.	
	Need more participation from all KLCC members to include facilitating groups at CDMP Hearings, attending kiosks & Council Meetings/Discussions. The Community Representative's terms also need to change to correspond with the MCK Chiefs term of office.	
	The OCC representative is the legislative political tie whose link is required for KLCCs future.	
	Quorum: changed to " 50% voting Commissioner representation" Code of Conduct: added to 7.4: "However, community representatives may accept a per diem for their attendance at duly convened KLCC meetings	

	or functions offered by the KLCC." Responsibilities: added to 4.7: technical "drafting team(s), and submitted"
	added to 4.9: " subject to funding ensures proper and timely translation of all legislation into the official language"
3. CDMP Revisions	Conducting focus groups with past CDMP Hearing participants to obtain more feedback on revisions in preparation for the final report due in September.
	It was noted that the Political Assessment is done by Council Table after request for legislation has been categorized and before it goes to Council for confirmation.
4. Other	Tobacco Law: Unanimous agreement from KLCC to delay assignment of First Hearing date because: 1) Election Year and Chiefs haven't chosen portfolios; 2) Bobby needs to bring Tobacco Law to Council stressing the importance of Chiefs' participation at CDMP Hearings because their role is as Chiefs in Council and not as Community Members; 3) KLCC needs to bring CDMP legislative calendar to Council for approval; 4) Chiefs Orientation & training until mid-August; 5) Staff unavailability, and 6) Staggered vacation period.
