1. ROC August 13/14	Please review and send any changes by tomorrow @ 4:00 p.m. as they will be finalized at that time.
2. File Updates	<p>Justice: The Justice meeting is cancelled for tomorrow and will be rescheduled. Incidental amendments need to be made on the 40 communal Laws. Grand Chief Mike Delisle would like to have a briefing package from Justice by Monday September 8, 2014 for a tentative upcoming Community meeting. The financial & operational implementation package is estimated on a spectrum between \$300K to \$500K.</p> <p><i>ACTION: Ron will provide Grand Chief Mike Delisle with a briefing package by Monday, and an informal Council Information session meeting for the Justice System (Act) will be booked by September 15, 2014.</i></p> <p>KFHL (MRI): The Second & Final Hearing is scheduled for tomorrow night at the Golden Age Club with Joe Delaronde as the facilitator. A review of all the Laws will need to be conducted and then a memo must be sent out. All Laws need to have a Time Line compiled like the one completed for the Justice Act and the Tobacco Law.</p> <p><i>ACTION: At the Hearing, Ron will explain the Urgent Process, Kahsennenhawe will do the Opening Address, and Leslie will do the Introduction.</i></p> <p><i>NEXT STEPS: Ratification by the People, go to Council for an MCR (Council Agenda Enactment Package with Technical Team presenting financial & operational implementation plan). The Technical Team has 1 year + 1 day to put the Family Homes Law back through the regular CDMP otherwise it becomes null and void.</i></p> <p>Tobacco: Peggy and Dennis reported the completion of the Tobacco feedback report is set for the end of September. Two radio shows are scheduled for September 11 & 25, 2014. Peggy will contact Joe to discuss the development of</p>

an information show for local television. Dates for three tentative upcoming Stakeholder meetings will be announced. The first Stakeholders meeting was August 7, 2014 with Onkwatah'karitáhtshera (Onkwa). Waiting to receive additional questions on Tobacco Law from Onkwa.

Elections: Trina C. Diabo reported that she conducted a survey over a two-day period. The report will be posted online once she and Joe meet to review. The next Election Law hearing is September 23rd, 2014 to re-ask the question, "**Do you agree to reduce the number of chiefs from 12 to 9?**". If the community members are unable to reach consensus, then the number of chiefs to run for council will remain the status quo (12).

If time permitting at the hearing on Sept. 23rd, Trina would like to ask the two remaining questions: (1) There is an Electoral Officer and an Assistant Electoral Officer, but should there be a pre-election decision and committee review board? (2) Should there be a post-election appeal process?

The discussion led to Chief Martin Leborgne strongly disagreeing with the CDMP definition of consensus, maintaining that he personally feels that every person at the Hearings must agree. Martin excused himself from KLCC (resigned) and expressed that he would attend CDMP meetings/hearings and voice his opinion as a community member and not as a KLCC member. A motion to move forward with the definition of consensus as per the CDMP where consensus is reached even though a minority is not in favor of that decision. All members were in favor of the motion.

Membership: Should the Membership Law include a review of the mandate through the "Will of the People" to include Residency as a new question?
ACTION: Kahsennenhawe has set September 16, 2014 as the target date to conclude Membership.

3. Other
Website Update: The new required field for telephone was added on the CDMP website.
ACTION: Leslie will add that the personal information is confidential and will not be made available.
