	Tobacco Law – Leslie in Bobby's absence -The September 29 th ROD was posted onlineThe agenda for the next meeting will address the first four (4) sections of the draft Law. The Portfolio Chiefs and the MCK technician will need to be sitting at the table to answer questions as resource persons. The Chiefs are encouraged to be there to ensure the protection of the communityThere was supposed to be a talk show today on tobacco. Portfolio Chiefs had to cancel due to scheduling difficulties. It has been rescheduled for next Thursday; same day as the Tobacco Law First Hearing. Gina and Peggy will be on the radio.
	ACTION: It was agreed to have one (1) group with three (3) facilitators to expedite the process.
	Status KLCC – Kahsennenhawe -Senior management priority setting has not happened resulting in no request or discussion for the permanency of KLCC. Appropriated funds are almost exhausted, so funding will have to come from elsewhere. Perhaps exploring alternate funding sources become a priority. Kahsennenhawe & Leslie are willing to write a proposal.

-Determination of Leslie's supervisor is questionable for the Portfolio Chief as the supervisor. Possible perception or potential for political interference.

-Mandate should be passed before Christmas 2015. The following changes were made to the KLCC Mandate:

2.1 the KLCC consists of five (5) MCK appointed and four (4)KLCC appointed Commissioners nine (9) representatives who serve as "Commissioners" and up to two (2) Kahnawa'kehró:non Ratitsénhaienhs who serve as the "Chiefs Advisory Committee" for the KLCC – one lead and one alternate. All of these representatives are appointed by a Mohawk Council Executive Directive (hereinafter MCED). The Mohawk Council delegates authority to KLCC to select . They are:

2.1.1 Commissioners

The following will be appointed by MCED:

- an Office of the Council of Chiefs Secretariat Representative;
- a Legal Services Representative;
- a Communications Representative;
- a Justice Representative; and
- the KLCC Coordinator

The following will be appointed by resolution of the KLCC:

- an Ad Hoc MCK Organizational Organizational Representative
- three (3) Community Representatives (includes one (1) youth).;
- the KLCC Coordinator.

2.1.2 The Chiefs Advisory Committee

- two (2) Kahnawa'kehró:non Ratitsénhaienhs one lead and one alternate
- The Chiefs Advisory Committee is non-voting positions.

2.1.3 The Chiefs Advisory Committee is non-voting positions.

3.0 QUORUM

- 3.1 quorum is achieved with 50% voting Commissioners representation; and
- -KLCC Revisions could pass before Christmas 2015, otherwise in the New Year.
- -CDMP Procedural Manual does not require an RFD
- -KLCC Community Representatives Received Vernon Goodleaf's Letter of Intent to maintain his seat as KLCC Community Representative.
