2. File Update REVIEW/DECISION	A) KML Drafting instructions – Jean The lawyer requires drafting instructions from the technical drafting committee (TDC). The following was outlined by the KLCC present: The TDC compiles the consensuses from the First Hearing and conveys the general consensus to the assigned lawyer. The lawyer will contact the TDC if there are any questions. Comment boxes are used to detail the reason for the change in the draft law, the date of the consensus, and the date of the change. The lawyer returns the law with the comment boxes to the TDC who in turn reviews for accuracy. ACTION: KLCC STAFF A standardized format for the lawyers and the drafting team needs to be developed based upon instructions and format used for the Justice Act. B) KFHL – Leslie It was noted that a request was received by the Portfolio Chief and Technician for an extension to begin the Regular Process for the KFHL. The manual states that a law is removed from the Legislative Calendar if inactive. KLCC unanimously agreed they could not grant an extension. ACTION: LESLIE Send notification to Portfolio Chief and Technician informing that KLCC could not grant an extension as they are required to begin the Process with a Community Consultation before December 8, 2016 or the law would become null and void. C) Election Law – Kevin The Election Committee has determined that modifications are needed before the next election and plan to submit a request to KLCC in early 2017. D) Telecommunications – Ron/All After a brief discussion it was determined not suitable to be discussed or handled by KLCC.
