Proposed amendments to Sanitary Conditions Law to undergo 30-Day Review

(Kahnawake – 28, Enniskó:wa/March 2011) The Lands Unit of the MCK wishes to advise the community that the 30-day review of the draft amendments to the Sanitary Conditions Law will begin on Tuesday, 29 Enniskó:wa/March until Onerahtókha/April 29, 2011.

The proposed amendments have been determined a Type 2 legislation, meaning that it is one that affects "a segment or specific interest within the community."

"There is a real need to create more effective regulations to allow us (Kahnawà:ke) to better control landfill and other substances that are brought onto the Territory," said Environment Portfolio Chief Clinton Phillips.

As indicated in the Community Decision Making Process, Type 2 legislation must go to a community review process that consists of a 30-day review and up to three public readings. Next steps will be announced by the Legislative Coordinating Commission.
